Ulla-Klinger-Cup: Team Classification: for every competition the ranking of the best diver of a team (club or federation) will be taken into account.

Entry Fee: 15,00 EUR per diver per event, if final entry has been made until September 18, 2019, after that date 18,00 EUR per diver per event

Other Fees: The costs for accommodation at the Bungalow-Park Hoog Vaals including breakfast, lunch and dinner are 65,00 EUR per person and per day.
